Training for SHINE Tutors

This 3-hour training prepares you the student to tutor older immigrants mainly in the areas of English as a Second Language and citizenship, and possibly in native language literacy and basic computer skills. At the training session, you will be given materials that were developed at the national office. You will also become a member of the national Project SHINE program.
